
## How to Allow (or Block) Camera and Mic Access in Chrome


If you want to block a website from accessing your mic or camera, or if you want to allow a website to access them, you can do so under Chrome's settings menu.

1. Open Chrome and select the Chrome menu, represented by three vertical dots in the top-right corner.


## 2. Select Settings




3. Scroll down and select Advance



4. Under the Privacy and security section, select Site settings.




5. Select either Camera or Microphone to access either setting.



6. Make sure the "ask before accession" is toggled on. If you see hangouts.google under the block section click on the trash can.

NOTE: If you remove a website from the block list, it doesn't move it to the allow list and vice versa. Instead, deleting a website from Chrome's list of blocked sites lets you choose to allow or block permission the next time the site requests access to either your camera or mic.
